Students will learn to develop a passion for language study through a curriculum that is rooted in inclusive practise. Students will learn to communicate confidently across a broad range of thematic areas, allowing them to use the target language in familiar and new contexts across KS3 and KS4. Students will repeatedly revisit topic areas over time to ensure that they build proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Students will be able to use and describe language with curiosity and interest, demonstrating knowledge and skills in the meaningful application of phonics, vocabulary, and grammar. This will allow students to communicate freely, precisely, and creatively in both formal and informal contexts.

Students will become confident linguists who share an appreciation for people of different cultures, customs, and traditions. As global citizens, students will use their linguistic knowledge and skills to communicate with people of different linguistic backgrounds demonstrating tolerance, respect and understanding for all.
