

### Year 10 CF2: Assessment Information

Art	Students grade is based on workshop work in preparation for starting their first portfolio which will be worth 60% of the final grade.
Biology/ Chemistry/ Physics	Students have sat a full triple paper 1 for biology, chemistry and physics.
Business Studies	Students have sat end of topic assessments for the units that they have currently studied, and two papers based on all content studied so far.
Child Development	Students have completed the coursework unit Component 1 - Children's Growth and Development This covers: Learning Outcome A - understanding the principles of growth and development Learning Outcome B - understand how factors impact on children's overall development
CNAT Sports Studies	CF2 data is based on current coursework grade for R085.
Combined Science	Students have sat a full paper 1 for chemistry and physics as well as 2 mid-point assessments and 2 end-point assessments for chemistry and physics.
Computer Science	Students have sat end of topic assessments for the units that they have currently studied, and two papers based on all content studied so far.
Construction	Students have been completing end of topic exams in Unit1 and they have been completing practical projects based on their skills of joinery, tiling and painting/decorating (Unit 3).
Creative iMedia	Students grade is based on the compulsory coursework that students have completed R094.
Drama	Grade is based on their presenting and performing texts mock which is worth 30% of the final grade.
English Language	Students had completed their Language Paper 2 Section A Summative Assessment which informed how they have been progressing in English
English Literature	Students had completed the Poetry Anthology assessment from their Literature Paper 2 assessment

Enterprise	Students grade is based on the compulsory coursework that students have completed R068.
Food Technology	Written assessment 50% based on a knowledge test of food science – physical and chemical properties and functions of ingredients. 50% practical, based on a variety of practical outcomes.
French	A written assessment including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 90-word question based on familiar prompts</li> <li>• Translations into Target Language.</li> </ul> The assessment questions centered on the current topic of study: leisure and free time.
Geography	GCSE Standard questions. Topics studied have included: The Living World and Coasts.
Health & Social Care	Students have completed the coursework component R033: Supporting individuals through life events. This covers: Life stages Impacts of life events Sources of support
History	Students have completed end of unit assessments for Paper 3: Weimar & Nazi Germany using past paper questions.
Maths	CF2 Assessment covered all blocks taught since CF1. Topics covering: -Vectors -Sine rule -Cosine rule -Bearings -Similarity -Enlargement -Time, money and measure circles.
